

# **POSITION SUMMARY**

#### **COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER (CHW)**

- Frontline public health worker who is a trusted member of and/or has a close understanding of the community served.
- Serve as a link between health services and the community to facilitate access to services and improve service delivery.

### LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE (LPN)

• Remove sutures, change sterile dressings, tracheostomy care duties, administer medication, and some Hemodialysis, Peritoneal Dialysis, and IV duties.

# TRAINING AND PREREQUISITES

- Completion of an approved CHW Training Program by SD DSS.
- Certification through Indian Health Service Community Health Representative basic training, a CHW program approved by the South Dakota Board of Technical Education or the South Dakota Board of Regents, or a CHW training program approved by the State.
- High school transcript or GED.
- Complete training program approved by SDBON.
- Complete ACCUPLACER test.
- Complete TEAS.
- · CPR certification.

• No certificate or license is required in SD.

· LPN license required by SDBON.

### **TYPICAL SUPERVISORS**

- Clinic, nursing, or another organizational manager.
- RN or physician.
