- Certification through Indian Health Service Community Health Representative basic training, a CHW program approved by the South Dakota Board of Technical Education or the South Dakota Board of Regents, or a CHW training program approved by the State.
- High school diploma or GED.
- 18 years or older.
- Complete an ASHP-accredited training program and obtain national certification through PTCB or ICPT.

• No certificate or license is required in SD.

• Technician License, Board of Pharmacy.
