ICAP CHWs help clients gain confidence and self-sufficiency through advocacy and care.

Inter-Lakes Community Action Partnership (ICAP) is a community-based non-profit organization that serves primarily low-income families and senior citizens in a 14-county area of East Central South Dakota. The CHW Program at ICAP works to provide Social Determinants of Health resource coordination for patients who experience barriers to their healthcare.

CLIENT BACKGROUND

When the CHW was contacted, the client has been dealing with a sagging brain condition. However, the causes of this condition remained undetermined as he had not been able to make the necessary appointments. The client's soft-spoken nature has posed obstacles in being able to adequately express his concerns and seeking the necessary medical attention. These challenges posed a barrier to accessing healthcare for the client.

SERVICES PROVIDED

The CHW has been instrumental in facilitating effective advocacy and securing vital healthcare appointments for the client. By joining the client on a phone call to his provider, the CHW has been an essential advocate, helping the client address his needs and concerns with his healthcare provider. The CHW also helped by providing him with encouragement and advice on how to better advocate for himself. The client has been empowered to navigate the complexities of the healthcare system with greater confidence and ease than he had previously.
